

Information for New Knowledge Bowl Coaches



Below is some basic information that may be helpful to you and will insure that invitationals, as well as sub-regional and regional events run smoothly.



Invitationals – listed on our website

- prior to the event
 - register with the host coach indicating number of teams
- at the event
 - take number of teams registered
 - provide reader/judge(s) based on number of teams
 - provide “working” equipment

Sub-Region & Region Events – listed on our website

- register with the SWWC Service Cooperative (registration form available on website)
- number of teams for Jr. or Sr. High Program

Note: you are obligated to bring the number of teams registered to the event. If anything happens to change that number, please contact me immediately. You are still liable for payment for that team, but I can contact other schools about bringing an alternate team so that the event can run as planned – 3 teams per room.

- at the event
 - take number of teams registered
 - bring team rosters, code of conduct forms (students & coach), district participation form
 - provide reader/judge(s) based on number of teams
 - provide “working” equipment
